Any traditional design or feature can be recreated incorporating the benefit of double-glazing. While timber will require some

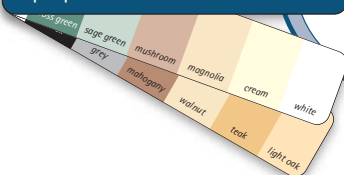
